Administration

- No report

<u>Personnel</u>

- At the present time we have 11 volunteers. I am working to onboard 3 new volunteers in June, two of them will be considered in-district and one would be a shift volunteer.
- We did loose one of our shift workers this month as he took a job in Florida.

Operations

- To date we have run 25 calls and things remain slow, but I expect we will begin to pick up as the County begins to reopen.

Communications/Jeffcom

Over the last year I have noticed an issue with our dispatching from Jeffcom. We have two radio systems VHF & 800. At the present time GGFD does not get dispatched on the 800 side unless it is a call that AMR is assigned to. So, if we get toned to a fire, we only get toned on VHF which is a problem as VHF does not work everywhere in our district. Bottom line is that it will cost us \$8,300.00 to resolve this issue, I will go into more detail on this issue and why it is occurring at the meeting.

- I have received the permit for the replacement of the station 3 septic tank. The contract to replace the tank was awarded to R.M.R Ramstetter Excavating and work should begin in a couple weeks. The tank is now completely full, and we will need to get it pumped prior to replacement.

- We replaced a faulty starter solenoid on Tender-83
- We repaired some leaky valve stems on E-81
- We purchased a pressure washer and misc. cleaning supplies for station 3
- The bollards have been installed in front of station 3
