Administration

Personnel

- Currently have 17 total members, 16 of which are active on the department including myself.

Operations

- We ran 129 calls in 2021, which equates to about a 30% increase in call volume from 2020.
- I am working on the IGA with TLFD for our shared shift program and shared recruitment & retention employee.
- Provided mutual-aid on the West Ranch Fire in Indian Hills, the Oak Fire with West Metro & the Marshall Fire in Boulder.
- We started our shared shift program with TLFD.

Education/Training & Travel/

- The 2022 joint fire academy with TLFD will be starting January 30th, we have 18 recruits between both agencies.
- I completed a 3-day ICS-300 incident command class, a FEMA IS-00800 class and my 3-year long task book to become certified as a Strike Team Leader for wildland fires. I will be taking a 2-day S-215 fire in the urban interface class next month then begin working on my Task Force Leader certification.
- Captain Enright is doing a great job in his new position and is working well with Chief Bondus at TLFD.

- Currently have 16 new homes in planning or under construction in the district.

- Received the final drawings for station 81, have two contractors working on bids.
- New gear racks have been installed at station 81, and the old gear lockers that were inside the kitchen area have been moved to station 83.

- We will be burning off the grass at station 81 & 82 when we have the correct conditions to do so. This will be done to reduce the fuel load around the stations and provide training for our members.
